
The World's "MOST GENEROUS" Country: TURKEY

According to the ODA Preliminary Data 2016, having provided 5,8 Billion USD of humanitarian assistance which equates to % 0,74 of its Gross National Income (GNI), our country once again has taken its place among the leading countries in this field.

Strengthening Turkey Growing TİKA The number of TİKA overseas country offices, which was 12 in 2002, rose to 56 by 2016.






The Number of Projects Shows How Actively TİKA Works

1992-2002=2240 2002-2016=18716






We Are the Most Generous Country in Terms of Humanitarian Assistance


According to the Global Humanitarian Assistance Report 2016, Turkey was the most generous country in the world that provided the largest humanitarian assistance in terms of its ratio to national income.

In 2015, Turkey was the second largest donor of humanitarian assistance in 2015 with an aid of \$3.2 billion following the U.S.







We Achieved a Record Increase in Development Assistance

Turkey has broken a record increasing its official development assistance (foreign assistance provided by all governmental agencies) 80 times in the last 13 years.

Turkey increased its official development assistance from \$76 million in 2003 to \$6.182 billion in 2016.







We Are Engaged in Activities Concerning Human Life From Birth to Death

As TİKA, we implement projects in a very broad area from education, health and agriculture to economic development, promotion of cultural heritage projects and training programs.

By reflecting the knowledge and experience of all public institutions and agencies, universities, local administrations and non-governmental organizations to the world, we lay the foundations of a new humane diplomacy.

Briefly, we are engaged in activities concerning human life from birth to death. The number of hospitals / health centers constructed, renovated and equipped in the last 6 years is 358. The number of health care personnel provided with training is above 3,400.

Approximately 750 million people in the world do not have access to clean drinking water. We drilled more than 1,200 water wells between 2003 and 2016. More than 47,000 specialists from various occupational groups, including security, judicial, health care, education and diplomacy, were provided with training in the capacity building programs of TİKA between 2003 and 2016

Additionally, more than 10,000 expert trainers from various public institutions and universities of Turkey were assigned for the on-site training programs. We deliver vocational courses for the disadvantaged people of the society, including women, the handicapped and low-income people, with a sustainable and versatile point of view towards development.





We keep our word to the least developed countries

Our President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan promised to provide the least developed countries with an annual support of \$200 million in the Least Developed Countries Summit of the UN in 2011.

The total assistance provided by Turkey between 2010-2015 to the Least Developed Countries (LDC) whose population constitute 10 percent of the world population rose to \$1.7 billion.

We Support Agricultural Development

Specialized training courses and implementation projects are devethe Humanitarian Relief Foundation (IHH) in 2013. In the last 9 years, more than 3,000 experts benefited from the training programs implemented in the agricultural, forestry and fishing sectors with the cooperation of the Ministry of Food, Agriculture and Livestock and TİKA.

A greenhouse was set up for the first time in Somalia within the agricultural school established in Mogadishu in cooperation with

as melon and aubergine were cultivated for the first time, and traiin agricultural production and modern agricultural techniques are ning on the use of drip irrigation systems and technical apiculture was delivered for the first time. With the school transformed into a Faculty of Agriculture within Zamzam University as of 2015, contributions are made to ensure propagation of modern agricultural techniques in Somalia.

We Support NGOs as Our **Solution Partners**

450 projects and activities were carried out in more than 70 countries with the cooperation of TİKA and NGOs between 2012-2015. The number of cooperating stakeholders increases each year, and activities are carried out with 80 domestic NGOs in average annually. Only in the sub-Saharan countries, more than 300 thousand people were subjected to medical checkup within the scope of the health care projects carried out in cooperation with NGOs.

We Set Up Modern Facilities

The world's most modern and hygienic bread factory was set up by TİKA in Bishkek, the capital of Kyrgyzstan.

The factory with a daily production capacity of 30,000 breads also serves as one of the most important production facilities of Kyrgyzstan with its production area as well as administrative units, meeting hall, laboratories, flour warehouse and numerous sections. It provides free bread to public facilities that render social services, such as schools, kindergartens, hospitals, orphanages and nursing homes.

More than 6 million children lost their lives last year. 60 million people, most of whom are children and women, are homeless due to wars, violence and natural disasters. It is the women and children who are


natural disasters.
